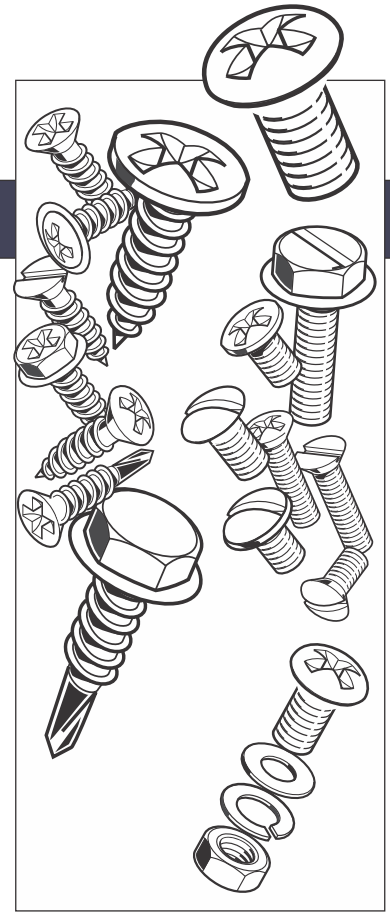
SCREWS

DESCRIPTION

The life-long question hasn't been answered. What is the difference between a bolt and a screw? Even Design Engineers have a difficult time answering. At The Nut Place, we draw two distinctions that make it easier to understand, but still don't come close to answering the question completely. Screws have two categories:

Sheet Metal Screws Machine Thread Screws

Sheet Metal Screws are pointed and have coarse threads that do not accept a nut by design. Machine Thread Screws are not pointed and are designed with a machine thread to accept a nut.
